I am in receipt of Mr. Bulow's letter of the 8th instant respecting the S.S. "KIRUNA" (Messrs. Aktiebolaget Gotaverken's No. 355) and with regard to the stud link chain cable I have to inform you that as the 135 fathoms of this 2.24 cable are of the weight and test as required by this Society's Rules and have been tested by the Surveyors to the Germanischer Lloyd the cable in question can be recommended to the Committee for approval, but that the notation C.P. cannot be made in the Register Book.

So far as the spare bower anchor is concerned I have to return herewith the Bureau Veritas Certificate forwarded with Mr. Bulow's letter, and to request that you will endeavour to obtain particulars of the test, and state whether drop, bend and hammering tests have been carried out. On receipt of this information the case will be further considered.

Kindly return the certificate with your reply.
