I have to refer again to the case of the "LALANDE" about which I wrote to you on the 4th April. The Owners say that arrangements have now been changed, and they will not be sending the vessel to the Gareloch to lay up.

They have, in fact, sold the ship to a firm in London for breaking up after one more voyage to the Far East, providing the buyers are satisfied with the examination of the ship, and this Society is prepared to allow the voyage with a valid load line certificate.
