This submission cancels Messrs. Furness Shipbuilding Co's letter referred to, as the Owners have now expressed a desire for Byers make of anchor to be fitted.

It will be observed that some of the anchors are slightly below the rule requirements, but in each case this is more than made up by the excess of weight in the cables.

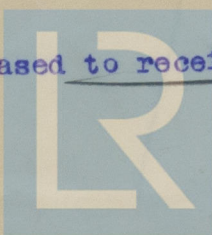
