The remarks of the Chief Ship Surveyor are desired on this case for the consideration of the Classing Committee.

("The endorsement to contain a succinct summary of any repairs that have been required and to show the cause or causes of such repairs, and also to bring out clearly any exceptional features in connection with the case, so that the Classing Committee may have all the salient points presented in the endorsement."—Extract from Sub-Committee's Report, 24/5/92.)

The class is subject to indented shell plate H6 from aft(p.s) being dealt with at the Owners' convenience.

The Sourabaya Surveyor, now reports the vessel afloat and additional reinforcement fitted to hold bulkhead webs and girders and hold and 'tween deck stiffeners in way of deep tank aft, for the carriage, of molasses, in accordance with endorsement dated 11.10.39.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed without record of survey and to have the notation "Carrying molasses in DTa", subject as above.
