## SOURCE OF INFORMATION

SVANO.—Stockholm, Oct. 9. — Steamer Svano, 3230 tons deadweight, belonging to Rederi A/B Rex, Vesteras for Holland, cargo ore, sprang a leak on Oct. 8 outside Sodertelje; vessel sinking.

SVANO. — Helsingborg, Oct. 10. — report from Sodertelje states that steamer Svano, which sprang a leak that port on Wednesday (Oct. 8), has almost completely sunk. Only part of the forecandle and the bridge deck are above water. Salvage vessel Neptun is on the scene with divers. It is considered that salvage will be difficult and pontoons will probably be used to help raise the vessel. — "Helsingborgs Dagblad." (See issue of Oct. 10.)

Helsingborg, Oct. 11.—It has not yet been decided whether steamer Svano can be salvaged. According to a report received yesterday morning, it appears unlikely that she will be salvaged. The vessel, which was loaded with ore, has gradually sunk and only the funnel is now visible above water. — "Helsingborgs Dagblad."

SVANO. — Gothenburg, Oct. 23.—Steamer Svano, which grounded at Sodertelje on Oct. 8 and had to be beached in vicinity of the oil port, will probably be broken up on the spot. The vessel was to have been taken out of service for breaking up at the end of the year. — "Svensk Sjöfarts Tidning." (See issue of Oct. 14.)

SVANO.—Gothenburg, Jan. 8.—The owners of steamer Svano, which grounded at Sodertelje on Oct. 8, report that the vessel must be considered as lost. — "Göteborgs Handels-och Sjöfartstidning." (See issue of Oct. 29.)
