The freeboard marking has been verified and found to agree with the freeboards given on certificate No. 18618 dated 3rd April 1942 which is returned herewith.

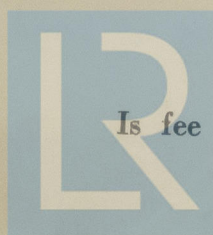
