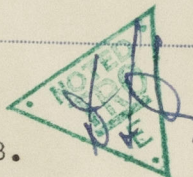

The Surveyor states there is no spare propeller on board.

IT IS SUBMITTED that this vessel is eligible for the Records Class Contemplated,

"Fitted for oil fuel, F.P. above 150° F" now and WILL BE eligible for the Record LMC with date on completion. subject to the supply of a spare propeller.

To complete the Machinery Survey all Rule requirements remain to be complied with except examination of:-

Sea connections,  
Both turbo feed pumps,  
Main condenser,  
Thrust and intermediate shafts,  
HP feed heater,  
Auxiliary generator lubricating oil coolers,  
Air receiver,  
Steam pipes,  
also First Entry Reports 4a, 4d and 13 required.
