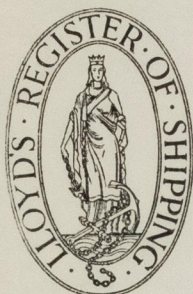

*Surveyed the s/s "MOHIB MARCEL" 5285 tons gross of Beirut whilst afloat at Alexandria on the 25th August 62, and subsequently on account of condition of class, general examination for postponement of special survey "p" due October 62, and repairs.*

*and that I am transmitting to the Committee of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, London, a Report, stating that all repairs recommended by me have been completed to my satisfaction, also that I am*

**Recommending** *that she be continued as now classed without subject regarding repairs to No.4 plate on the 3rd below sheer port side in way of No.6 hold also without subject regarding repairs to wasted plate on the 3rd below sheer in way of the boiler room starboard side but subject to the shell plating in way of the 4th below sheer port side at No.485 frames (counting from collision bulkhead) being specially examined and dealt with as found necessary by November 62, also subject to all conditions at present attached to the class being dealt with as previously recommended.*
