The Owners have assured us to-day that this ship will definitely be withdrawn from service for breaking up on the 29th of August, 1960.

This morning I carried out a general examination of the hold, decks, hatchways, ventilators, air pipes and their closing arrangements, also casings, machinery space, windlass and steering gear and found these parts in efficient condition.

The repair to the air pump casting was examined and found efficient.

In view of the fact that the ship is to be withdrawn from service within the next 29 days no certificates were issued and no fees charged. I trust this action is in order.
