Additional accommodation now fitted at the after end
of bridge deck space on starboard side for 8 gunners.

Steel companion 2'-8" x 2'-8" with 18" sill and strong wood door
operated both sides fitted on bridge deck.

N.R. storm valve for W.C. discharging overboard about 18" below
freeboard deck.

Tonnage opening on starboard side of aft bridge bulkhead
plated over.

1-10" sidelight in ship's side, 1-10" and 1-16" sidelights in aft
bridge bulkhead all fitted with hinged D.Ls.

1-12 vent. 30" coaming fitted on bridge deck and 1 torpedo vent
to W.C. fitted in aft bridge bulkhead.
