

Dear Sir,

In reply to the enquiries contained in your classing letter of the 7th instant regarding the steamer "NEPTUN" Hamburg Report No 16808 I have to state as follows:-

Thickness of the strake below the sheerstrake at the breaks is 16 mm and not 15 mm as stated in the report.

The length of the poop is 143.31 feet. The length of 160 feet as given in the report is the extreme length.

The number of watertight bulkheads extending to the upper deck, for record in the Register Book, is 10.

As the forging report for the vessel's rudder appears to have gone astray, a photographed copy of the yard's report is attached.

The diameter of the safety valves is 105 mm.
