

The First Special Survey No.1 became due on this vessel in September, 1930.

In reply to enquiry the Owners write that it has definitely been decided to allow the vessel's class to lapse and she has now been placed under the Board of Trade for classification purposes.

The year of grace expired at the end of last month.

The Classing Committee had the case before them on Friday, 16th instant, when they decided to give instructions for the vessel's character to be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
