I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have had under consideration the Reports received from the Society's Surveyors in London of partial Classification Survey held on the motor ship "EMPIRE CONFIDENCE".

It appears that the greater part of the requirements of the Special Survey No. 3 necessary for class has been complied with.

As an interim arrangement pending completion of Survey for the assignment of class the Committee have assigned a special record of "100A1 (Class contemplated) Examined 5.40", indicating that the vessel has been examined by the Society's Surveyors and found or placed in efficient condition for a period of 6 months from that date.

The full fee for classification in accordance with the scale adopted by the Committee in similar cases will be £115.0.0 for the Hull and £55.0.0 for the Machinery, of which amounts an account is enclosed for the proportion of the work now done leaving a balance of £45.0.0 for the Hull and £35.0.0 for the Machinery to be charged on completion of the Survey for full classification.
