With reference to the survey of the above vessel with a view to classification with the Society, I have to acquaint you that the plans of machinery submitted by you have been examined and, in the special circumstances, the machinery of this vessel will be eligible for the record of L.M.C. (with date) but without the distinguishing mark , provided as much of the main and auxiliary machinery be opened up now as circumstances permit and found in good condition, and the remainder be dealt with within twelve months, the details be found in accordance with the plans, the pumping arrangements be examined and found in good order and in accordance with the plans, and the glass gauges on the deep oil fuel storage tanks and settling tanks be replaced by fittings complying with the requirements of the Rules. <
