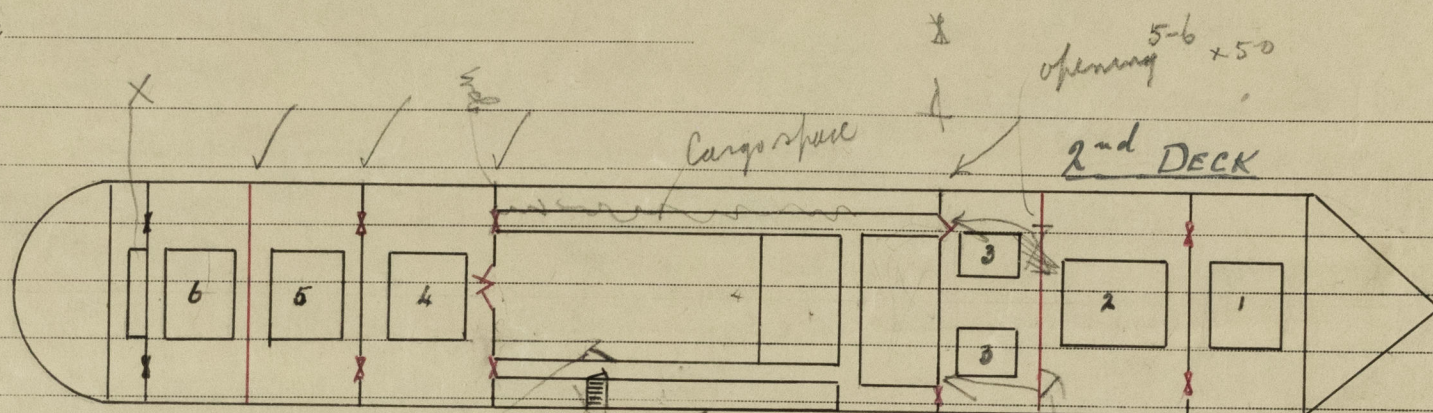

Memorandum of alterations reported since ship was surveyed for assignment of Load Lines in



ALTERATIONS SHOWN IN RED.

In Shelter Deck Space

Nos. 1 to 2 holds bulkhead, Port and Starboard tonnage openings closed, by welded plates.

Additional bulkhead fitted, with no tonnage openings.

Bridge Front:- Starboard side tonnage opening closed by riveted plate.

Port side pressed steel door opening from both sides.

Bridge after bulkhead:- Port and Starboard tonnage openings, closed by welded plates.

Double steel doors, fitted on after engine room bulkhead 5'0"x5'7" height 13 sill.

✓ Nos. 4 to 5 holds bulkhead, port and starboard openings closed by welded plates.

✓ Nos. 5 to 6 holds bulkhead, additional bulkhead fitted, with no tonnage openings.

Starboard side Bridge housing: new companionway from shelter to main deck:-

Hard wood door size 5'6"x26" sill 18". Pressed steel, hinged door, also fitted for security purposes.

The above alterations were found to have been effected at some previous date.
