in August, 1940

An opening has been cut on starboard side of forward bulkhead
in tonnage well on freeboard deck (aft bulkhead of bridge) leading to
Defence Personnel Accommodation. The opening is 28" wide with 24" sill
and closed by wooden door. This work was stated to have been carried out
in London in June, 1941, and the Master was unable to produce a Rpt. CL1
(Contd.) regarding same.
