Steam Tender "KILLARNEY"

I duly received your letter of the 2nd instant, and have since reported your remarks to the Committee here.

It is noted that the vessel has been taken out of commission, but as it is not clear whether it is the Commissioners' intention to sell her for breaking up or to keep her laid up for some time, it will be much appreciated if you are able to clarify the position.

If the vessel is to be sold for breaking up, the Committee will probably delete the class and assign a notation of "To be broken up", whereas if she is to remain out of service pending a definite decision, in all probability the Committee will assign a notation of "Repairs required - Class suspended".
