Dear Sirs,

With reference to your telephone message of to-day regarding the "EMPIRE BARON", I have to acquaint you that in June last, the Society's Surveyors at Calcutta held a survey for the renewal of the Load Line Certificate of this vessel, but as she has not been assigned Convention Freeboards as a British ship, the Owners were informed that in order to obtain British Load Line Certificates it would be necessary for full particulars to be obtained for the re-assignment of Convention Freeboards. In the circumstances I shall be glad if you will forward full particulars on Report Cll and Report Cll(Comp).

I may say that in view of the information previously furnished by you, the report (Cll) was sent to the Dundee Surveyor on the 5th instant. In the circumstances the Surveyor is being requested to forward this document direct to you for your information and guidance.
