Dear Sir,

I have to acquaint you that in June last, the Society's Surveyors at Calcutta held a survey for the renewal of the Load Line Certificate of the motor-ship "EMPIRE BARON", ex "MONTE PIANA", but as the vessel has not been assigned convention freeboards as British ship, the Owners were informed that in order to obtain British Load Line Certificates, it would be necessary for full particulars to be obtained for the assignment of Convention Freeboards.

The Owners now state that the vessel is due at your port shortly and in the circumstances I shall be glad if you will forward full particulars on a form C11 and C11(Comp) for freeboard assignment.

Report 11(b) is enclosed herewith for your information and guidance and should be returned to this office, together with your reports.
