

This is to Certify that I have
 Surveyed the S.S. "STARAS" of Panama, Gross tonnage - 4779, No. in
Register Book - 80452, as she lay at New Harbour Wharf, Bangkok,
 for the purpose of examining Fore Mast Damage.
 and that I will transmit to the Committee of Lloyd's Register of
 Shipping, London, a Report, stating that all repairs recommended by
 me have been completed to my satisfaction, also that I will
 Recommend that she be to be retained as classed without fresh
record of survey, recommending permanent repairs to carried out
in Japan. The fore mast being unusable for unloading cargo, by
doubly staying the mast, there will be no reason for collapse on
voyage.

being fit to carry dry and perishable cargo.

It is stated -

Whilst discharging 40ft length of iron rods in 2 bundles, from No. 2
 hold at 0430 hrs. on the 29th June, 1959, the iron jammed in the hold
 and excessive strain was put on the derricks causing the fore mast to
 buckle slightly about 20 ft from the deck, this damage was caused by
 carelessness on the part of the Stevedores.
