It is submitted the Freeboards given on the accompanying form, being those required by the Tables, merit approval. *subject to*

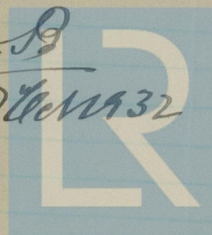
- ~~(1) Ventilator with 9' 6" opening, in fore end, being slayed to fore-castle deck~~
