I beg to acquaint you that the Society's Surveyors at Genoa have forwarded to this Office your letter of the 20th ultimo addressed to them respecting your steamer "CONFIDENZA".

The case has been submitted to the Committee at their meeting to-day. who note with regret the reason for the decision conveyed in your letter, and in the circumstances instructions have been given for the vessel's character to be withdrawn from the Society's Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.

I may add that in view of the withdrawal of this vessel's class, the record of the freeboard assigned by the Committee, together with the corresponding draught, will also be withdrawn, and the freeboard certificate is thereby cancelled and should be returned to this Office.
