Dear Sirs,

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 9th instant, respecting the fees chargeable in the case of the new s.s. "ROBILANTE" (ex "WAR PROJECT") Messrs. The Furness Shipbuilding Co's No.14 vessel, and with regard thereto I have to inform you that accounts have to-day been rendered to the Accountant General, Ministry of Shipping, for the fees due for the survey during construction of the hull and machinery, and for the survey and assignment of freeboard of this vessel, as under:-

On payment of these fees, £60:7:7 of the machinery fee will be due to your port for the survey of the shafting and installation on board of the machinery, together with the hull and freeboard fees.
