With reference to the Glasgow first entry report .39387 on three Babcock & Wilcox Boilers No.410 tendered for a Standard vessel of the "N" Class, I have inform you that the Society's Surveyors at Middlesbrough report that these boilers have been fitted into the s.s. "OBILANTE" (ex "WAR PROJECT"), Messrs. The Furness Shipbuilding Co's No.14 vessel.

An account has to-day been rendered to the Ministry of Shipping for the fees due for the survey during construction of the hull and machinery of this vessel, and on payment £36: 4: 6 will be credited to your port for the survey during construction of the boilers at the makers' works.
