With reference to your first entry report No. 4413 on the Double Reduction Gear made by Messrs. D. Brown & Sons for a Standard vessel of the "N.1" Class, I have to inform you that the Society's Surveyors at Middlesbrough now report that this gear has been fitted into the s.s. "ROBILANTE" (ex "WAR PROJECT"), Messrs. The Furness Shipbuilding Co.s No.14 vessel.
