Further to our Newcastle Report No. 104516 with regard to the above vessel, we have to state that, owing to prevailing conditions, the diesel generator clutch, lubricating oil cooler, fresh water heat exchanger and oil fuel service tank were not delivered in time to be fitted. Modifications have now been made and the diesel generator satisfactorily tested under working conditions.

The Owners' Representative states that the clutch etc. will be fitted on the vessel's return to the United Kingdom from her present voyage.

As the class of the vessel is not affected, no mention of this has been made on the Interim Certificate issued.
