LP Cylinder Cover found broken by loose piston stud. New cover made and fitted.

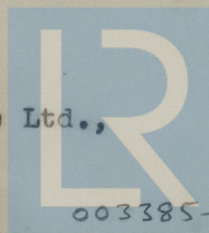
Starboard Generator
