Steamer "LARGES BAY"

The Society's London Outdoor Surveyors have stated that you desire to be advised regarding the last record of survey of the port, centre and starboard generator engines of this ship.

In reply I have to inform you that according to our records all three generator engines (port, centre and starboard) were examined throughout at Durban by this Society's Surveyor during the period 3rd June/5th July, 1957, and repaired as found necessary. After repairs all three generator engines were satisfactorily tested under working conditions.

In connection with the above survey, the Society's Durban Surveyor issued a special report at the request of Messrs. John T. Rennie & Sons, Lloyd's Agents at Durban, and the Owners, in which he states that the matter was discussed fully on board with Mr. Cadenhead, and it is concluded that a copy of this report is in your possession.
