Dear Sir,

With reference to your letters of the 23rd and 27th instant respecting Glasgow First Entry Report No. 41612 on the Steamer "LARGS BAY", I have to acquaint you that the vessel is now at Tilbury, where it is stated that the remaining details concerning the Machinery are to be attended to and are expected to be completed on Monday next.

In the circumstances, the certificates of classification are being prepared with a view to being issued clean if possible on Monday or Tuesday, and I trust that this will meet the convenience of the Builders.

I shall be glad if the Surveyors will be good enough to state the length and capacity of the fresh water tanks between the tunnels, and they should at the same time say whether the figures given for the capacity of the deep tank represent oil capacity; if this is the case, the water capacity of the tank should be furnished, if it is intended to be used for water ballast.
