Memorandum of alterations reported since ship was surveyed for assignment of Load Lines
in

ALTERATIONS - TEMPORARY ACCOMMODATION FOR FORCES PERSONNEL.

COMPANIONWAYS - Temporary portable companionways, 2 of steel at N^o 2 hatch and 2 ^{of wood} at each of N^{os} 5 & 6 hatches, for access for forces personnel to N^{os} 2, 5, & 6 'tween decks fitted on N^{os} 2, 5, & 6 hatchways, on instructions from the Ministry of War Transport. Openings in companionways closed by hinged wood doors capable of being operated from both sides. Sills 30" above deck.

These companionways & arrangements for battening down the hatchways in way, are to be regarded as of a temporary nature, only to be "in situ" while the vessel is carrying forces personnel in the above 'tween decks, and the companionways are to be removed & the original hatch covers & tarpaulins fitted when the vessel is on her normal service.
