Steamer "EDDYREEF"

With reference to your telephone call today I confirm that it will be in order for you to issue a certificate for this ship to be towed to Antwerp to be broken up provided the requirements of Instructions to Surveyors, Part 11, 1954, receive attention and a General Examination in accordance with Circular No.1959 is held on the hull. With regard to the question of drydocking the ship this is left to your discretion, but I would stress the reference in the guidance notes to the Instructions that you will be expected to satisfy yourself that the fouling of the bottom is not sufficiently extreme to preclude the ship from being a towable proposition.

The certificate to be issued should state that the class is temporarily suspended for the voyage and that the stability and towing arrangements are not the responsibility of this Society.
