Dear Sir,

In my letter to you on the 17th April, I said that the Engineer-in-Chief of the Mersey Docks & Harbour Board was awaiting a decision from the Dock Board Management regarding the final date when the remaining dredging operations in the Mersey would be passed to the Westminster Dredging Co.

The date fixed was last Monday and it looks now as if the Dock Board will only carry out the necessary dredging operations in their own docks and not in the Mersey proper.

In my previous letter I gave you a list of the vessels which are at present laid up and the Engineer-in-Chief has promised that before any vessel is re-commissioned or sold they will advise this office.
