Messr.the Vulkan-Werke of Stettin-Bredow survey under construction and test two single ended boilers proposed to be fitted in the vessel No.212 building at Messrs.the N.V.vereenigde Scheepswerven van der Windt at Vlaardingen.

The materials used in the construction have been made at a works approved off by the Committee and tested by the Society's Surveyors as required by the Rules.The boilers have been constructed in general conformity with the approved plan and have been subjected to an hydraulic pressure of 24.3 kilogrammes per square centimetre and found tight and without alteration of form.

The boilers have been stamped on the front plate:-
