With reference to the Special Survey and Water Tube Boiler Survey which will become due at the end of next month on the Steamer "GLESSULA", I have to acquaint you I am in receipt of a letter from the Owners in which they state this vessel is due for periodical drydocking at Curacao during the course of the next month, when these inspections will be dealt with. In the circumstances I shall be glad if you will be guided accordingly.

I may add that the vessel's class is subject to repairs effected to the port and starboard main engine bedplates being further examined before the end of next month. It is concluded this matter will also receive attention when she comes under your inspection.
