The NEWCASTLE Surveyors report (12,52), this tanker examined in dry dock, bottom coated, and some minor wear and tear repairs effected.

On account of damage (cause not stated) permanent repairs effected to indented shell plating, etc., in way of No.1 cargo tank (p.s.).

The ship has, at this time, been converted from a trunk decker to a flush decker, in a similar manner to the sister ships "GEOMITRA" & "GEMMA", and in accordance with approved plans. Service limits "In all parts of the Caribbean Sea" have been introduced.

The equipment letter remains unaltered, see Endorsement dated 16.5.50 for sister vessel "GEMMA".

A forecastle has also been constructed and a number of other minor modifications effected.

IT IS SUBMITTED this tanker is eligible to have her class altered to *100A1 "Carrying Petroleum in Bulk" "For Service in all parts of the Caribbean Sea", with record of docking 12,52 and with Endorsement of Class (B).
