U.S. Maritime Commission attend the SS "FORT WINNEBAGO" Official Number 246,025 of Portland, Oregon at Jacksonville, Florida on the 26th day of August 1947, for the purpose of inspecting (a) protection of openings, (b) guard rails, (c) freeing ports, (d) means of access to crew's quarters, and found same to have been maintained in an effective condition; also, that no alterations had been made to hull or superstructure which would affect the calculations determining the position of the load lines.
