Steamer "GLENBRIDE"

With reference to Mr. Waggott's telephone call yesterday, I confirm that provided you hold a General Examination on this ship of sufficient extent to enable you to satisfy yourselves that she is fit for a voyage to Denmark, the Committee will be prepared to maintain the vessel's class for the period contemplated.

Our previous correspondence will have shown that postponement of the overdue survey until the end of the present month has already been agreed by the Committee, but if the ship does not leave your port by the end of this week, the question of the inspection required will be left to your discretion.

As previously stated the present Load Line certificate is valid until 16th June next.
