The items now surveyed are detailed on this report. All were found or placed in good condition unless otherwise stated.

NOW DONE - EXAMINED SHELL PLATING EXTERNALLY ABOVE LIGHT LOAD LINE AND VERIFIED BY SOUNDINGS THAT NO LEAKAGE IS TAKING PLACE INTO VESSEL.

ALSO EXAMINED SUPERSTRUCTURES, WEATHER DECKS, CASINGS, VENTILATORS HATCHWAYS AND ALL CLOSING APPLIANCES AND CONSIDERED SATISFACTORY FOR THE PROPOSED PASSAGE.

THE RUDDER QUADRANT HAS BEEN SECURED IN MIDSHIP POSITION AND ALL SEA CONNECTIONS AND TUNNEL WATER-TIGHT DOOR CLOSED.

THE SHIP WILL BE TOWED IN BALLASTED CONDITION AND ANCHOR AND CABLE EQUIPMENT (3 BOWER ANCHORS AND STORED FULL COMPLIMENT OF CABLE) IS ON BOARD FOR USE IN CASE OF EMERGENCY.

I recommend that this ship remain as classed with/without fresh record of dry docking is CONSIDERED TO BE IN A SATISFACTORY CONDITION FOR THE PROPOSED PASSAGE IN TOW AS A HULK FROM THE RIVER BLACKWATER TO HAMBURG, EFFICIENCY OR ADEQUACY OF THE TOWING ARRANGEMENTS NOT BEING THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THIS SOCIETY.

THE CLASS OF THE SHIP BEING TEMPORARILY SUSPENDED DURING THE PASSAGE IN TOW.
