Dear Sir,

With reference to your letter of the 23rd ultimo enquiring what fee should be charged for the portion of the Continuous Survey held on the oil engines of the Motorship "KING ALFRED", Glasgow Report No. 73393, and to my letter of the 22nd October last respecting the fees in this case. I have to acquaint you that a balance of about £35 is due for the Classification Survey of the machinery, plus £5 balance of electrical fee. Of this amount, it is considered that £31 should be charged at the present time, made up as follows:-

<u>Cardiff A/c:-</u>	£18 C.S.
	plus £ 5 balance Elec.
 Glasgow A/c:-	 £ 8 C.S.
 Total	 £31.

leaving a balance of £9 to be charged on completion of the Classification Survey.

I shall therefore be glad if you will be good enough to render an account for £31, of which £23 should be credited to Cardiff account on payment.
