Reverting to your Memorandum of the 25th May last, I have to inform you that the General Examination was duly carried out in dry dock at Kobe last August. The case has received the consideration of the Committee who have agreed to the Owners' proposal to postpone the Special Survey until July, 1963.


At this Survey, 150 fathoms of chain cable were found worn to renewal size. I shall be glad if you will ascertain from the Owners what early and definite arrangements they propose to make to renew this equipment.

Records of Docking Survey, Main Boiler Survey and Screwshaft Examination, all with date of 8,62, have now been assigned and the class has been continued subject also to keel plate No.14 and A.15 (port side from aft) being specially examined and dealt with as necessary by the Special Survey.

I shall be glad if you will inform the Owners accordingly and forward their proposals in regard to the equipment.
