In reply to your memorandum of the 25th May I have to say that the Committee are agreeable to a General Examination being held in drydock in the Kobe district in July next with a view to the postponement of the Special Survey until some time before the end of July, 1963.

The class is at present continued subject to keel plate No.14 and A.15 (port side from aft) being specially examined and dealt with as necessary by the Special Survey and to bottom shell plate (holed) in way of tunnel well being examined and dealt with as necessary and to frames (temporarily repaired) in engine room (port side) being renewed by August, 1962 and, as regards the machinery, to the base of the tailshaft cone in way of the keyway being re-examined by August, 1962 and to the main condenser discharge pipe outlet valve and shell connection being specially examined and dealt with as necessary by that date. Special attention should be given to these matters at the drydocking.


I take this opportunity to point out that the Main Boiler Survey will become due at the end of August next.
