C Dear Sirs,

Steamer "JALAKANTA"

I duly received your letter of the 31st May with enclosure regarding the maintenance of this ship in class for a further twelve months, and have to acquaint you that the Owners' proposal has been considered by the Committee today. In reply I am to say that provided the ship is opened up as for Special Survey C and all necessary repairs for a further twelve months trading are dealt with to the Surveyor's satisfaction, the Committee will be agreeable to assigning a notation of SS(Mod) valid for twelve months.

So far as the machinery is concerned, the H.P. cylinder and piston, one top and bottom end and two main bearings should be submitted to examination, and if found satisfactory no other part need be opened out, but a General Examination in accordance with Circular 1959 should be held.

It is noted the survey will be held in drydock and afloat at Calcutta and a copy of this letter is being forwarded to the Calcutta Surveyors.

For the issue of a new Load Line certificate, a Load Line Renewal Survey should be carried out in conjunction with the inspection referred to above.
