The Owners wish to dispose of the above vessel but have been refused permission by the Government of India for a further year and we enclose for your information a copy of the Governments letter in this connection.

The Special Survey became due in July 1961 but was deferred until July 1962 subsequent to a satisfactory General Examination having been held. The Owners, however are reluctant to carry out a full Special Survey and they request your permission to carry out a Modified Special Survey to enable them to operate the vessel for a further year.

Should your permission be granted the survey will be held in drydock and afloat at Calcutta.
