Reverting to your letter of the 1st September and previous correspondence regarding the Special Survey I have to advise you that the Society's Surveyors' reports of the General Examination which was carried out at Calcutta during the period September/October have now received the consideration of the Committee.

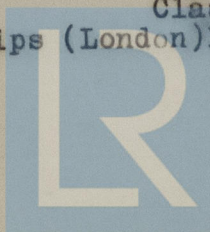
In view of the satisfactory nature of this inspection approval has been given for postponement of the Special Survey until July, 1962.

Fresh records of Docking Survey 9.61 and Main Boiler Survey 10.61 have now been assigned, and the class continued subject to indented shell plate H.5 etc. (starboard side forward), and set in shell plate E.5 (starboard side forward) being specially examined and dealt with as necessary at the Special Survey, and to the propeller being again examined and dealt with as necessary at the next Drydocking.
