This vessel is a "LIBERTY" ship of the E.C.2 type, the machinery having been constructed under the supervision of the American Bureau of Shipping; and Classification with this Society is desired.

A Special Survey with a view to Classification has now been held and a First Entry report forwarded.

From the particulars given, this machinery is identical with that of the Victory ships, S.S. "FORT COLUMBIA", etc., except for the electrical equipment, which is similar, and is such as could be accepted.

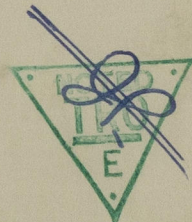
Feed water regulators have been fitted to the boilers at this time.

There is no spare propeller.

The American Committee have assigned a record of LMC 3.47, S 2.47, subject to a spare propeller being supplied.
