On July 5th, 1929, and subsequently attended trials and found everything satisfactory, there being practically no vibration of hull when running full speed. The machinery trial was also satisfactory, the three sets of main engines, also auxiliaries, running smoothly and showing no signs of heating. The vessel was given a series of trials over the measured mile, attaining a speed of 17.1 knots.
