We hereby engage to pay the established Special Survey Fees in accordance with the Society's Rules  
for Trawlers as follows, also the fees for inspection of installation of Electrical Fittings as set forth  
in the Society's Rules for Electrical Equipment.

For trawlers built under the special superintendence of the Surveyors (to entitle them to the distinctive mark  $\oplus$ ),  
2s. per ton gross. No fee to be less than £10.

For engines and boilers built under the special superintendence of the Surveyors (to entitle them to the distinctive mark  $\oplus$  in red):—  
Five shillings per Nominal Horse Power. No fee to be less than £9.

The Nominal Horse Power for regulating survey fees on engines and boilers to be determined as described in Section 29.  
Entry Fees as per Section 28 are additional to the above charges.

In exceptional cases an additional charge will be made according to the service performed, and in all cases where travelling  
expenses are incurred by the Surveyors in connexion with the above services, they are to be defrayed by the parties interested.

In no case can the vessel be classed until all fees, travelling expenses, &c., due thereon are paid.

This request is made upon the terms of the Rules and Regulations of Lloyd's Register of Shipping,  
which provide that:—

"While the Committees of the Society use their best endeavours to ensure that the functions of the Society are properly executed,  
it is to be understood that neither the Society nor any Member of any of its Committees is under any circumstances whatever to be
