In June, 1958 it was stated that the vessel was laid up  
at Bombay pending sale to Indian Owners. The Colombo  
Surveyors wrote on 1st November, 1960 that the ship had  
been <sup>(FOR DEBT)</sup> sold to Messrs. James Mackintosh & Co. (Private) Ltd.,  
of Bombay. The Bombay Surveyors stated on the 26th  
December, 1960 and 10th February, 1961 that no reply had  
been obtained from the present Owners to any of their  
letters regarding the vessel's future.
