We are in receipt of your letter of the 24th instant.

The above vessel has been sold subject to Government of India permission being obtained, to The United Iron Co., Bombay. We regret the sanction from the Government has not yet been received, but we expect to receive definite information in this connection shortly.

We are at the moment unable to say what will be done to the steamer, but if permission is eventually obtained, the carrying out of the survey to put the vessel in class will of course be the responsibility of the new Owners. If, however, the permission is not obtained, the Eastern Star Lines Limited, will then consider what is to be done with her, but, we gather that at the moment it is their idea to dispose of the vessel to whoever is able to obtain permission from the Government for the purchase of the vessel.

In the circumstances, you will appreciate that the vessel is still owned by The Eastern Star Lines Ltd., Colombo, for whom we are acting as Agents.
