We are in receipt of your letter dated 7th January, 1958, regarding our report No.4095 on the above vessel. As stated in our reply to your memorandum of the 31st October last, we were informed by the Owners that they intended to carry out the Special Survey of this vessel at Bombay, in December 1957, and that the Boiler and Screwshaft Surveys would be effected at that time. We have since been informed that the vessel is now at Bombay for the above purpose. The damaged shell plating referred to in the above report was not repaired here and it is presumed that this will be dealt with during the course of repairs at Bombay.
